MIRUS' *A PATH OF HIS OWN* FEATURED AT ART GALLERY OF ONTARIO

BRAMPTON, ONTARIO, February 25, 2006 -- The Art Gallery of Ontario has included the Mirus Films/Film Arts production *A Path of His Own: The Story of David B. Milne* as part of the exhibition "David Milne Watercolours: Painting Toward the Light." The film will be screened continuously during the run of the show which opened today and closes on May 21.

"Painting Toward the Light", which features 70 Milne works, was curated by the Art Gallery of Ontario's Katharine Lochnan and is a rare example of a Canadian artist having a solo exhibition that tours internationally. The show opened at the British Museum in July 2005. *A Path of His Own* was screened twice at the London show. After the London showing, the exhibition played in New York City at the Metropolitan Museum of Art in the fall of 2005.

A Path of His Own features Les Carlson (*X-Files*, *Anne of Avonlea*) as David Milne and is based on Milne's journals, letters, and his unpublished autobiography. It was written by Pat Patterson and produced and directed by Paul Caulfield. The sixty-minute documentary-drama won seven Canadian Film & Television Association Awards including Best Direction and Best Overall Production. The film has aired on CBC-TV, Radio-Canada, TVOntario, Bravo, and Vision TV and was featured at many film festivals.
